For the treatment of vitamin B and vitamin C deficiencies in horses, cattle, sheep, goats, swine, dogs and cats. For the treatment of cerebrocortical necrosis in cattle and sheep and for the treatment of bracken poisoning in horses.

### **DOSAGE**

Administer by subcutaneous, deep intramuscular or slow intravenous injection. The dose should be repeated daily as required. Normal aseptic precautions should be observed.

### Cattle and horses:

20 - 30 ml

### Calves, foals, sheep, goats and swine:

up to 15 kg : 5 ml More than 15 kg: 5-10 ml

1 ml

If dose volume exceeds 20 ml, it should be divided and injected into two sites.

Repeat dose if needed
