# Phenylject

Solution for parenteral administration

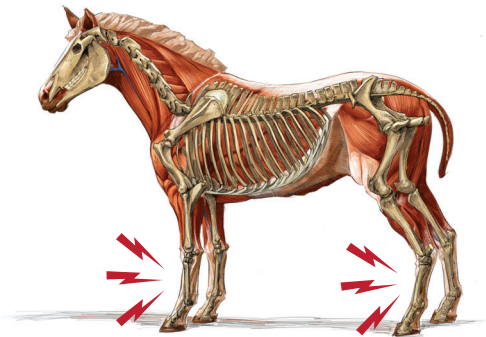
**Phenylbutazone is a pyrazolone derivative belonging to the group of antipyretic analgesics with besides analgesic and antipyretic also antiflogistic properties (NSAIDs). Phenylbutazone acts by inhibiting the production of prostaglandins.**

## INDICATIONS

Phenylject is indicated for the treatment of musculo-skeletal disorders in horses where the anti-inflammatory and analgesic properties of phenylbutazone can offer relief against inflammation, pain and lameness (e.g. osteoarthritis, acute and chronic laminitis, bursitis and carpalitis).

## COMPOSITION PER ML

Phenylbutazone ..... 200 mg.



## DOSAGE

For very slow intravenous administration.

### Horses:

1 ml per 45 kg (4.4 mg phenylbutazone/kg), with a maximum of 10 ml.

To be administered in a single dose, which may be followed if necessary by oral phenylbutazone therapy commencing 24 hours after the injection. In acute cases and in hospitalised animals it may be administered once daily for not more than five consecutive days. Observe aseptic conditions.

## WITHDRAWAL TIMES

Not to be used in horses intended for human consumption. Treated horses may never be slaughtered for human consumption.

## PACKAGING

Vial of 100 ml.



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
